



Windom Community Council Neighborhood Safety, Home Security Rebate Program Scope of Services & Budget

Background - In the fall of 2019, WCC deployed its neighborhood survey and learned that public safety was the top-rated concern. WCC Board members had previously inquired about instituting a home security rebate program for Windom, however, the COVID-19 pandemic interfered in our plans to implement the project. Today, with the general increase in crime in Minneapolis, and in Windom, and with the changes occurring with Neighborhoods 2020 and opportunities for plan modifications, the Board would like to implement a home security rebate program. The rebate program would make available up to \$500 per property to help safeguard Windom residents for both home and rental properties.

Resources - Reallocating \$40,000 of Community Participation Program (CPP) funds from Neighborhood Priorities/Reserve to Neighborhood Priorities/Resident Security.

Partners – WCC, City of Minneapolis: Neighborhood and Community Relations, Minneapolis Police Department: Office of Crime Prevention, Windom residents, Other partners.

Responsibilities – The Windom Community Council will:

- Work with NCR City staff to ensure best neighborhood home security rebate program practices are employed as the rebate program is developed.
- Will inform residents of the availability of these funds, condition for use, and access to the application form.
- Provide technical assistance to residents prior to initiating work as requested.
- Review any special request that might exceed \$500 based on extenuating circumstances.

This budget is to provide support for an estimated 75 residences in the Windom Neighborhood.
